The CMI Undergraduate Research Fellowship (URF) provides interdisciplinar research training to underserved research-oriented students who have a strong interest in pursuing a Ph.D. in the Biomedical field. This program was created to address the national deficiency of diversity in the biomedical workforce. The CMI URF at NC State University aims to contribute to diversifying the pool of students pursuing entry into Ph.D. programs in the biomedical field. Successful candidates will be drawn from academically motivated and disadvantaged students in the Biological Sciences, Chemistry, Psychology, Biomedical Engineering, and other Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math (STEM) disciplines.

Eligibility

- >3.0 GPA
- Sophomore standing or four more semesters of coursework beyond the 2022-2023 academic year
- A strong showing in the completion of STEM-related coursework
- A well-defended desire to pursue interdisciplinary team-oriented undergraduate research
- Demonstrate a willingness to engage in research professional development practices
- A commitment to our diverse community and values
- U.S. citizens or permanent residents
